This week we have been:

- Retelling 'The Enormous Turnip' using the story map we created.
- Showing our costumes to each other and talking about our favourite characters and stories.
- Writing about our favourite characters and books.
- Talking about growing and starting to explore some of our think bubbles (a think bubble is a question or idea that we want to explore)

In Maths we have been:

- Playing with patterns, we have used objects from around our classroom to create our own patterns.
- Making repeating patterns – red bear, blue bear, red bear, blue bear.
- Trying to develop more complex repeating patterns; yellow bear, blue bear, red bear, yellow bear, blue bear, red bear or cat, cat, dog, cat, cat, dog.

In Phonics we have been:

- Introduced to the digraphs 'ai' 'ee' and 'oa'
- Reading and writing words containing the digraphs – sheep, goat, rain, roast, leek, paint.
- Learning the tricky word 'my.' We have been using it to write about our favourite books and characters.
