


Maths Passports

Literacy In Literacy we will be:

- Learning and dramatising the story of Funnybones.
- Reading and writing non-fiction texts relating to bones and bodies.
- Writing skeleton poems.
- Continuing to build on our writing skills eg use of adjectives, verbs, sentence openers, and making sure our writing makes sense to others.
- Continuing to practise the reading and writing of the alternative spelling of vowel sounds e.g. s<u>ee</u> /s<u>ea</u> and sn<u>ai</u>l / pl<u>ay.</u>
- Remembering to use capital letters and full stops.
- Beginning to use other punctuation.

- Counting on from any given number
- More/less

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- Number bonds to 10/20
- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division
- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Solving word problems
