- Looking at the globe and maps to discuss our own journeys



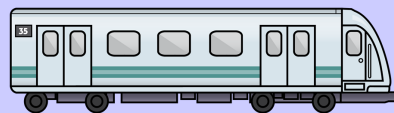
Other Activities to do at Home

We will still be swimming every Tuesday afternoon for the next five weeks. Please ensure your child brings along a swimming kit including goggles.



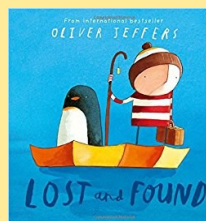
PE
