In Maths we have been:

- Carefully counting objects as well as steps, claps and jumps.
- Creating and experimenting with marks and symbols to represent number. Using drawings, lines |||| and dots ••••

In Phonics we have been:

- Using our wipe boards to create patterns. Eg. c
o c o c o and \\\
- Introduced to the phoneme 'c' 'k' and 'e' – we have tried to articulate 'c' 'k' and 'e' and mark make 'c' 'k' and 'e' and find 'c' 'k' and 'e' in words.
- Learning to read and write the tricky word 'the'
