Monday 14th May – Friday 18th May

This week we have been:

- Using clipboards to record our marks inside and outside of the classroom.
- Creating ramps using different materials and measuring how far our cars can go.
- Creating dens using fabrics, pegs and knots!

In Maths we have been:

- Using the vocabulary; adding, plus, add, equals.
- Introduced to the sign + and =
- Carefully counting spots on each side of the ladybird and adding them together to find the total.
- Starting to record some number sentences using marks and some numbers; $1 + 2 = 3$.

In Phonics we have been:

- Introduced to the trigraphs 'ear' and 'air' the three letters represent one sound.
- Reading, writing and doing the action for our new learning to help us to learn it. (hear, near, pair, hair)
- Introduced to the tricky word 'like' and practised writing the tricky words we have learnt so far. Carefully forming our letters.
- Learning the high frequency word 'her'.
