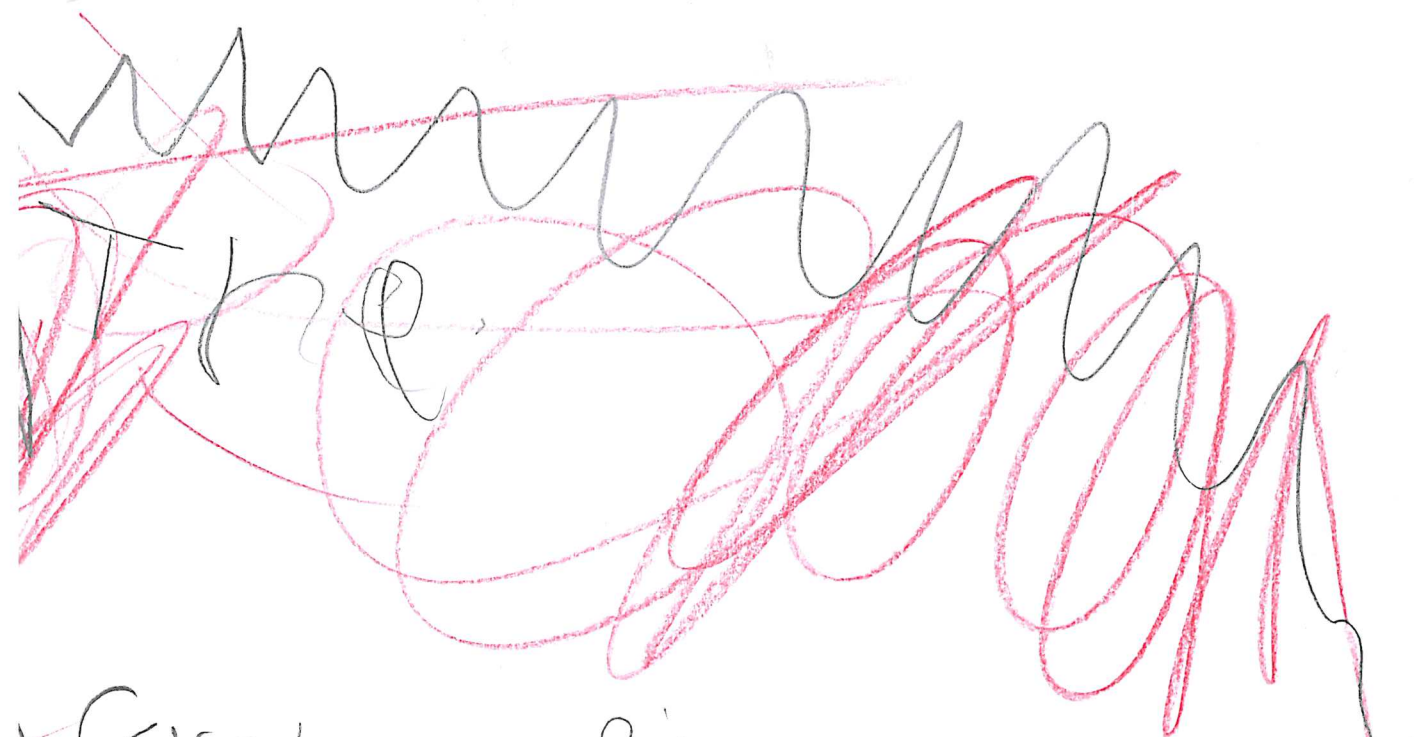
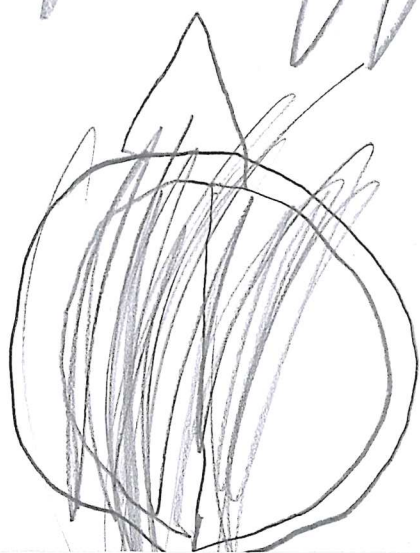
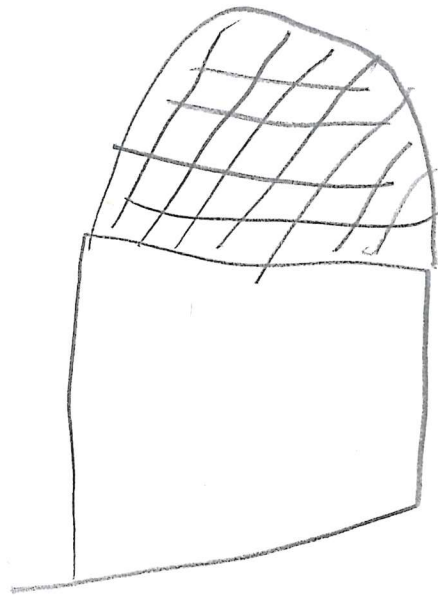




Grat fire of London

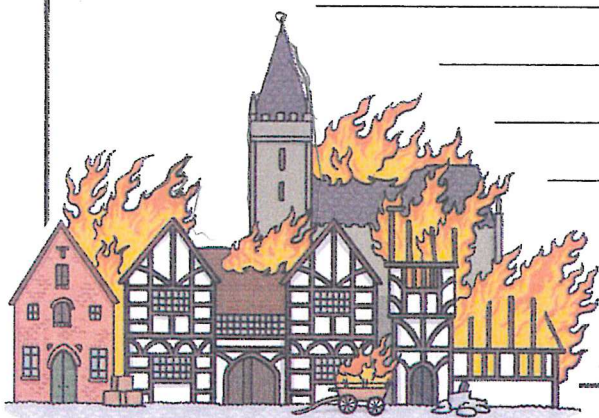




In 1666 London was

sky



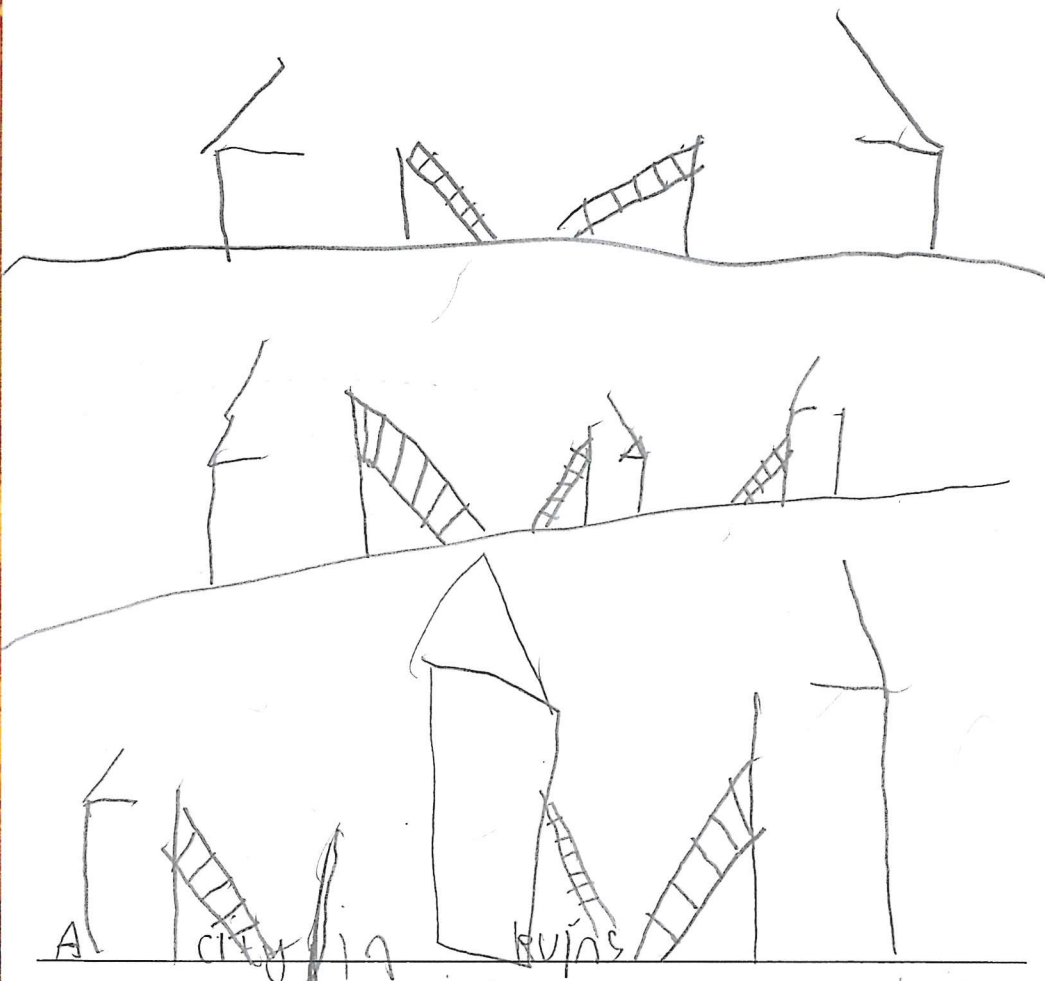


Tuesday 4th September

were sad



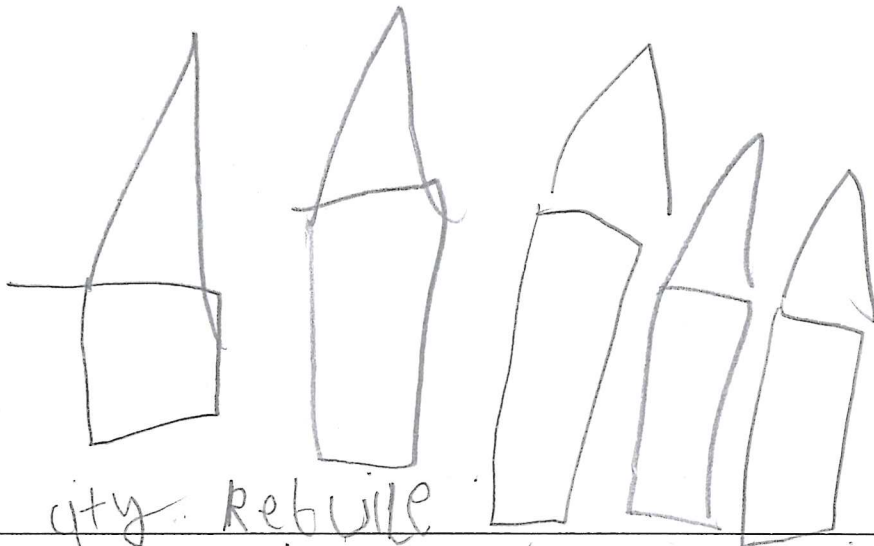
Wednesday 5th September
