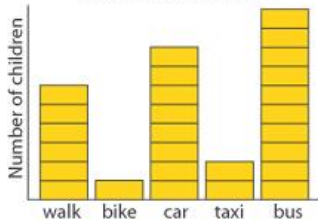
Task 4:

4. Tim is 67cm tall. Jim is 80cm tall. What is the height difference between them?	
5. Jack has 15 sweets and Claire has 30 sweets. How many more sweets does Claire have?
