Writing

In our writing this half term, we will be developing our caption and short sentence writing, beginning to add description. We will also be focusing on adding a capital letter and full stop to our sentence writing.

Reading

We will be focusing on increasing our knowledge and understanding of vocabulary from a range of texts and books.

We will be continuing to develop our word reading and comprehension skills, and begin to use the structure of a story to sequence our own ideas.

Understanding the World (Science, History, Geography, Computing)

We will be looking at and creating simple maps to support us in 'Going on a Bear Hunt'. We will be planting seeds and observing changes in growth over time. We will be practising orally giving a set of instructions (algorithm) to complete, for example, how to plant a seed.

Maths

We will be comparing and combining two numbers to 10, and beginning to recognise number bonds to 10. We will also be comparing capacity, length, and height, measuring our plants as they grow.

Circle time (RE & PSHE)

Ahead of Easter we will be looking at the Easter story and what this means both for Christians and non-Christians. We will be exploring other cultural celebrations including Holi. We will also be continuing to think about how we look after our bodies and our planet.

Expressive art and design (Music, Art and Design)

We will be exploring rhythm and recreating woodland sounds using instruments. We will also be using nature to add texture to our creations, experimenting with the different colours we identify in the environment.

This half term we will be focusing on practising ball skills, including rolling a ball to a target, stopping a rolling ball, developing accuracy throwing to a target and developing bouncing and catching using a ball.
