1. Reading comprehension:

Lighthouses – download the file and decide on which is the right level (1, 2, or 3 stars). Read the text and then answer the questions using the text to support you.

2. Writing: watch the short film clip 'The Lighthouse' on The Literacy Shed (https://www.literacyshedplus.com/en-gb/resource/the-lighthouse-ks1-activity-pack)

Watch the film again and with your noun spotter sheet see how many times you can see each noun in the film (eg how many times do you see the moon?)

Now, think of a verb that can be used with each noun (or other nouns that you spotted, not on the list) and add to the verb grid (eg shining).

Finally use the nouns and verbs to create your own verb poem about The Lighthouse – see the example to give you an idea.

Can you present your poem within a picture?

3. Write the story of the lighthouse. Can you change the ending so the lighthouse keeper solves his problem in a different way?

Maths: Multiplication (written method using and array and then a number line). Please watch the videos on youtube to show you how to work these out.

Art / DT: create a model or picture of Godrevy Lighthouse in a way you choose (eg collage, papier-mâché, painting, sketching, etc)

Music / Dance: listen to different songs or pieces of music that represent the sea. While you listen to them, draw a 'sounds of the sea' picture. Are your pictures different depending on the music you hear?

If you have instruments at home, you could create your own sea sound picture, or can you create a sea song?

Create a sea dance, thinking about how you can move to one of the pieces of music you listened to.
