In Phonics we have been:

- Learning the new digraph 'ng' (a digraph is two letters that make one sound). This is a hard sound to say as it is a 'throat sound'. We have rolling our picture dice and then sound-talking to write the 'ng' words on our wipeboards e.g. song, ring, bang, wing.
- We have also learnt the new tricky word 'my' (a tricky word is a word that you cannot sound-talk and blend). See if you can find this in any big books at home during half term!

In Guided Reading we have been:

• Sharing the book 'Cave Baby'. The children have used clay to pastels and crayons to do their own cave drawings and then we have used a tea bag to make them look like they are in a cave!

In Maths we have been:

 Naming and describing 2D shapes. We have talked about the properties of these shapes and have created different models and pictures with our shapes. See if you can spot any of these shapes in the environment!
