

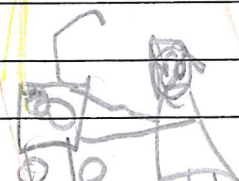
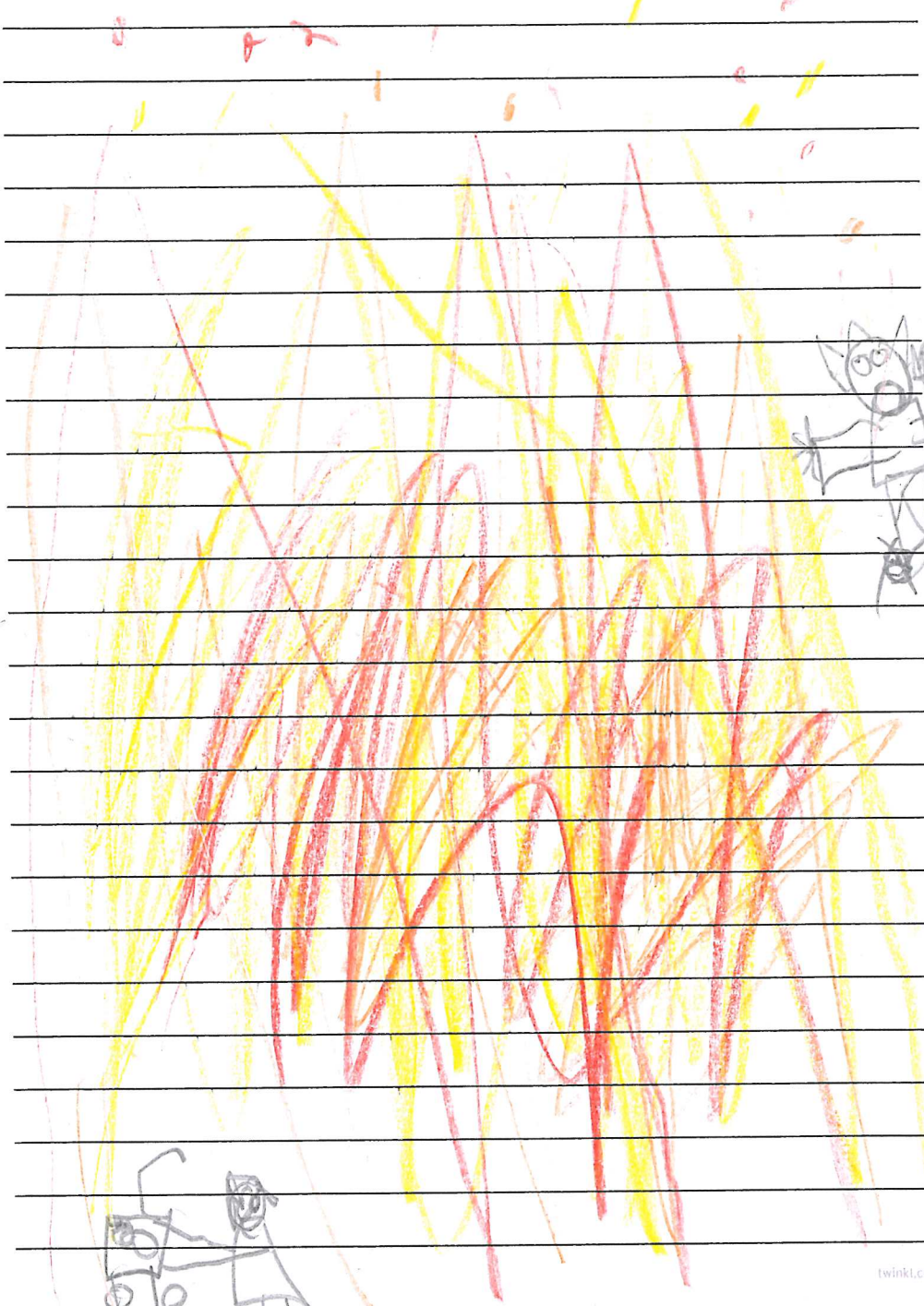

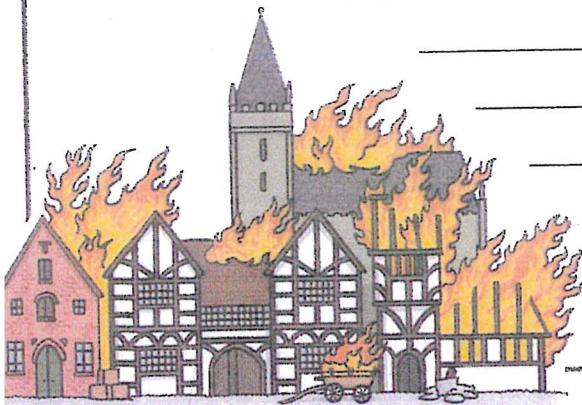
in 1666 London was

to the bakery.

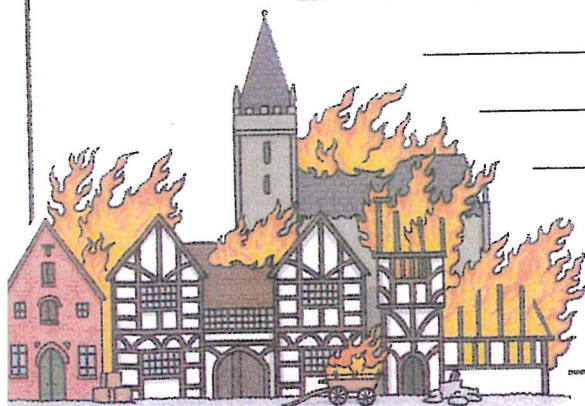




By Monday 3rd
