Makes 12 serves

Ingredien+s:

- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 onion, diced
- · 4 medium sized potatoes, peeled and chopped
- · 2kg pumpkin, peeled and chopped
- 2 litres vegetable stock (salt-reduced)
- 1 cup water

Me+hod:

- 1. Heat the oil in a large soup saucepan on a medium heat. Add onion and cook until soft.
- 2. Add the potatoes, pumpkin, stock and water and bring to the boil.
- Reduce to medium heat and cook for 30 minutes (or until pumpkin and potatoes are soft), stir occasionally.
- Take off heat.
- 5. Use a stick blender and blend until smooth.
- 6. Add pepper and/or nutmeg to taste and serve
