The fire fighters were so brave that they had to go into the fire was burning all the houses.


They had to shake out water to try to set the fire out.

Wen Wednesday 5th September


The King ~~orderd~~ orderd

shops the shops.




They demotished

were burnt down into ash





London was burnt down
