

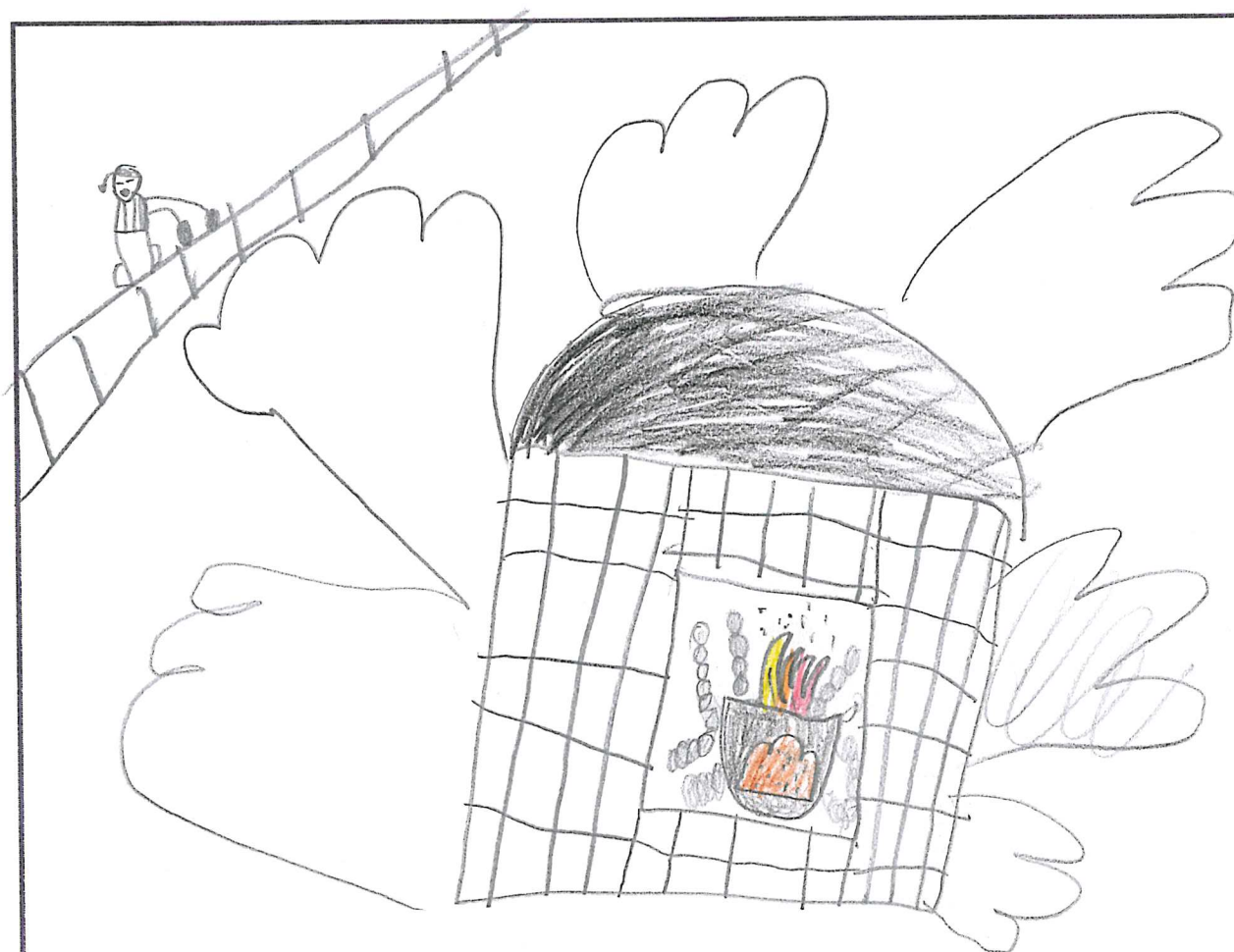

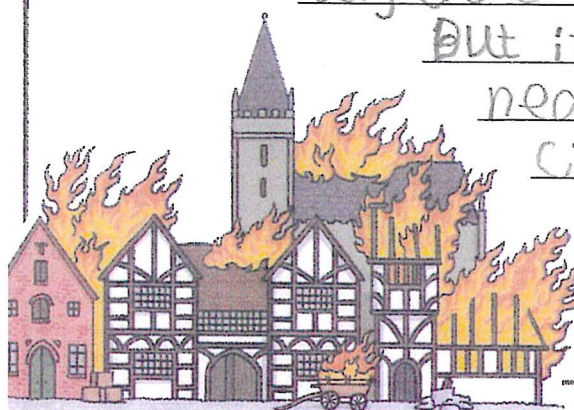


Monday 3rd September

~~the city was destroyed~~





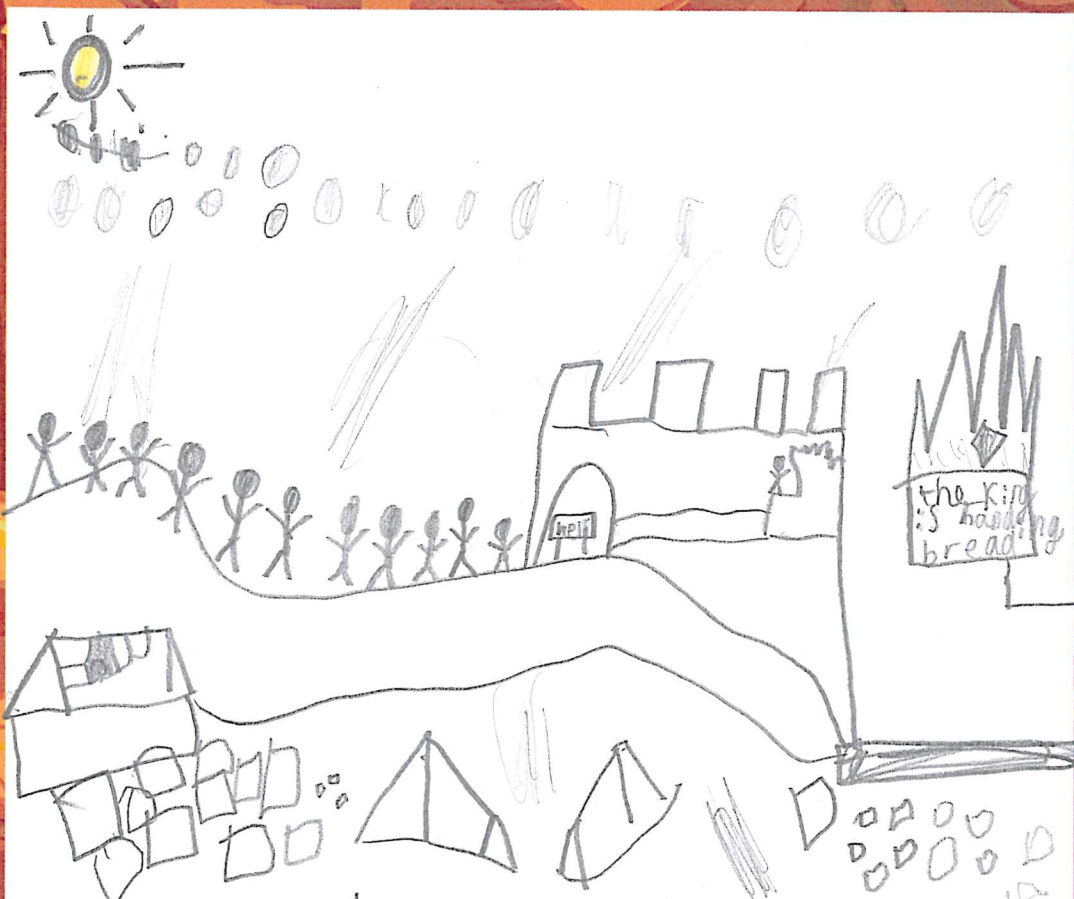
The fire in London was so bad

else.



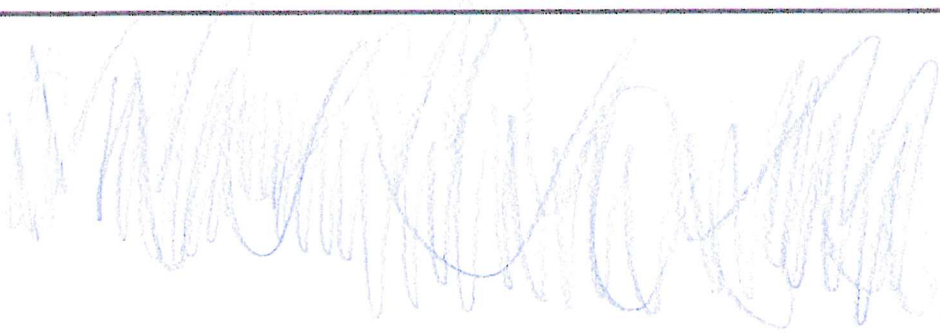
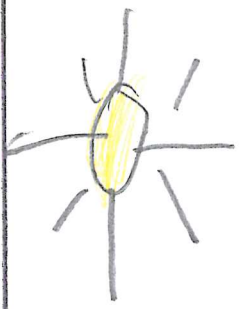
Wednesday 5th September
