

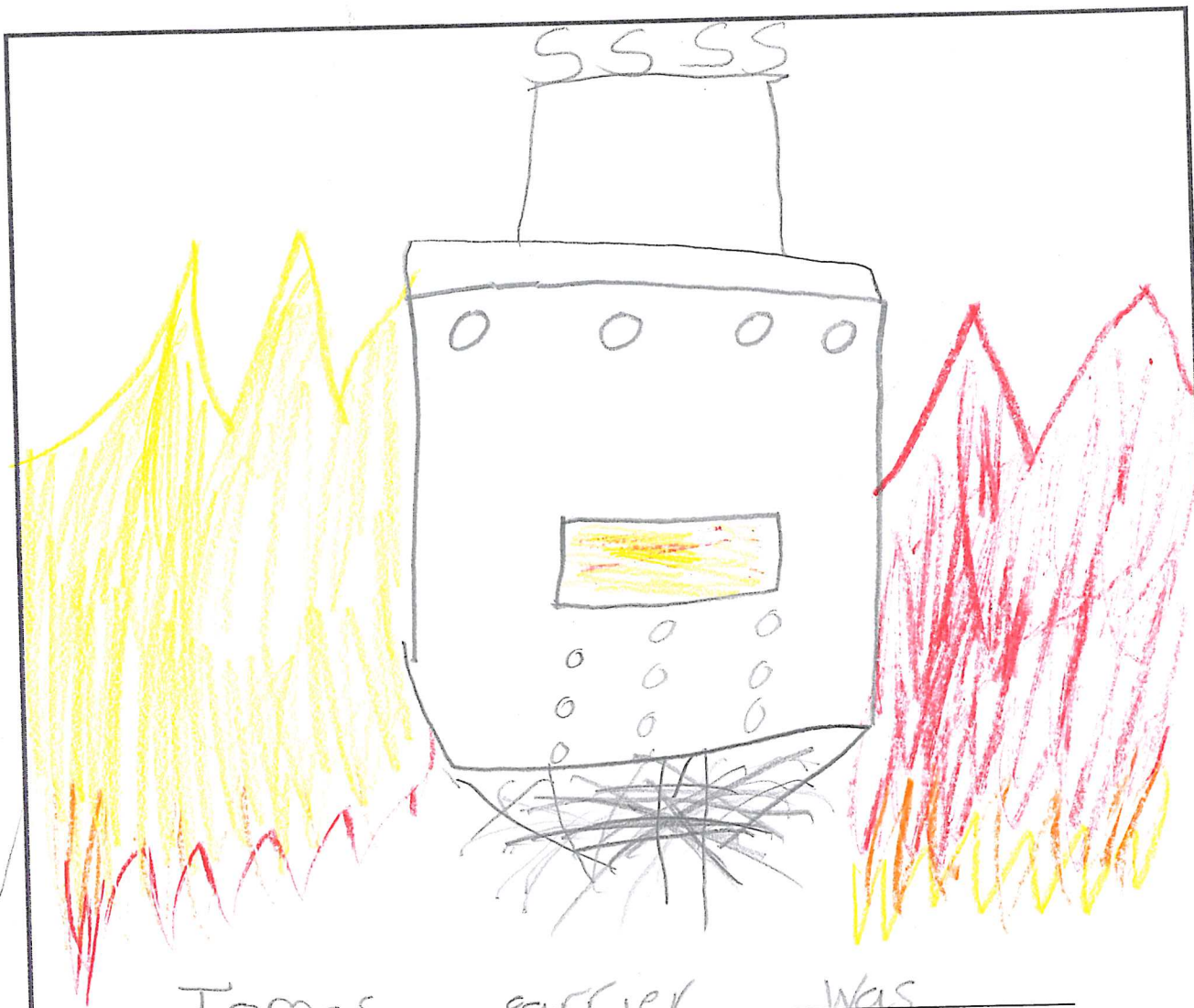
The great fire of London

oven open.

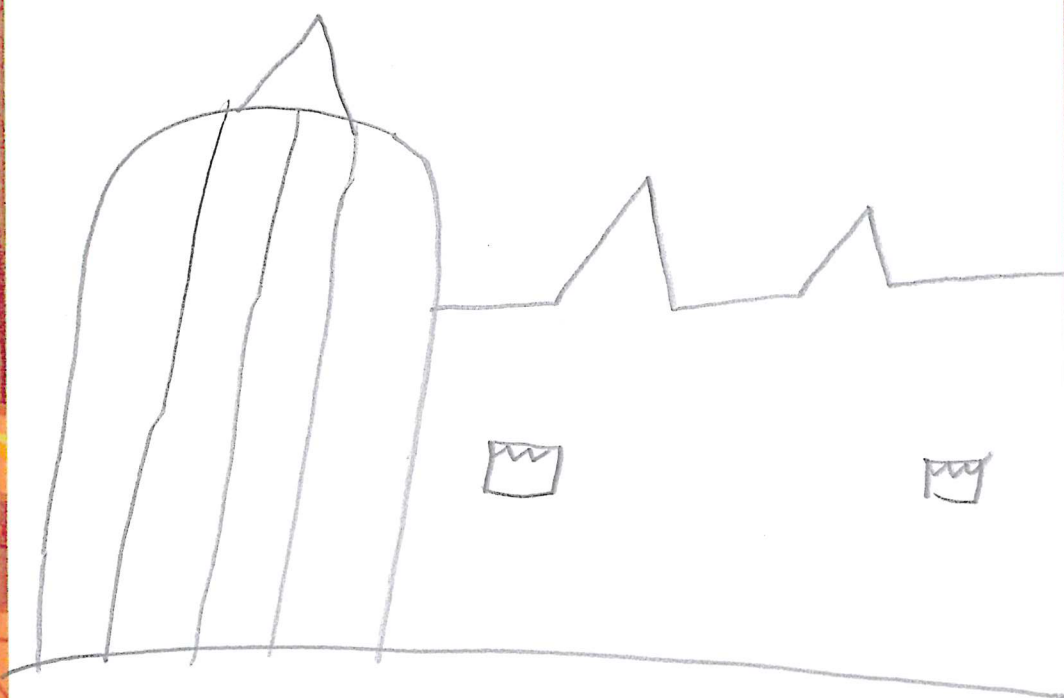


Monday the 3rd of September

dying.



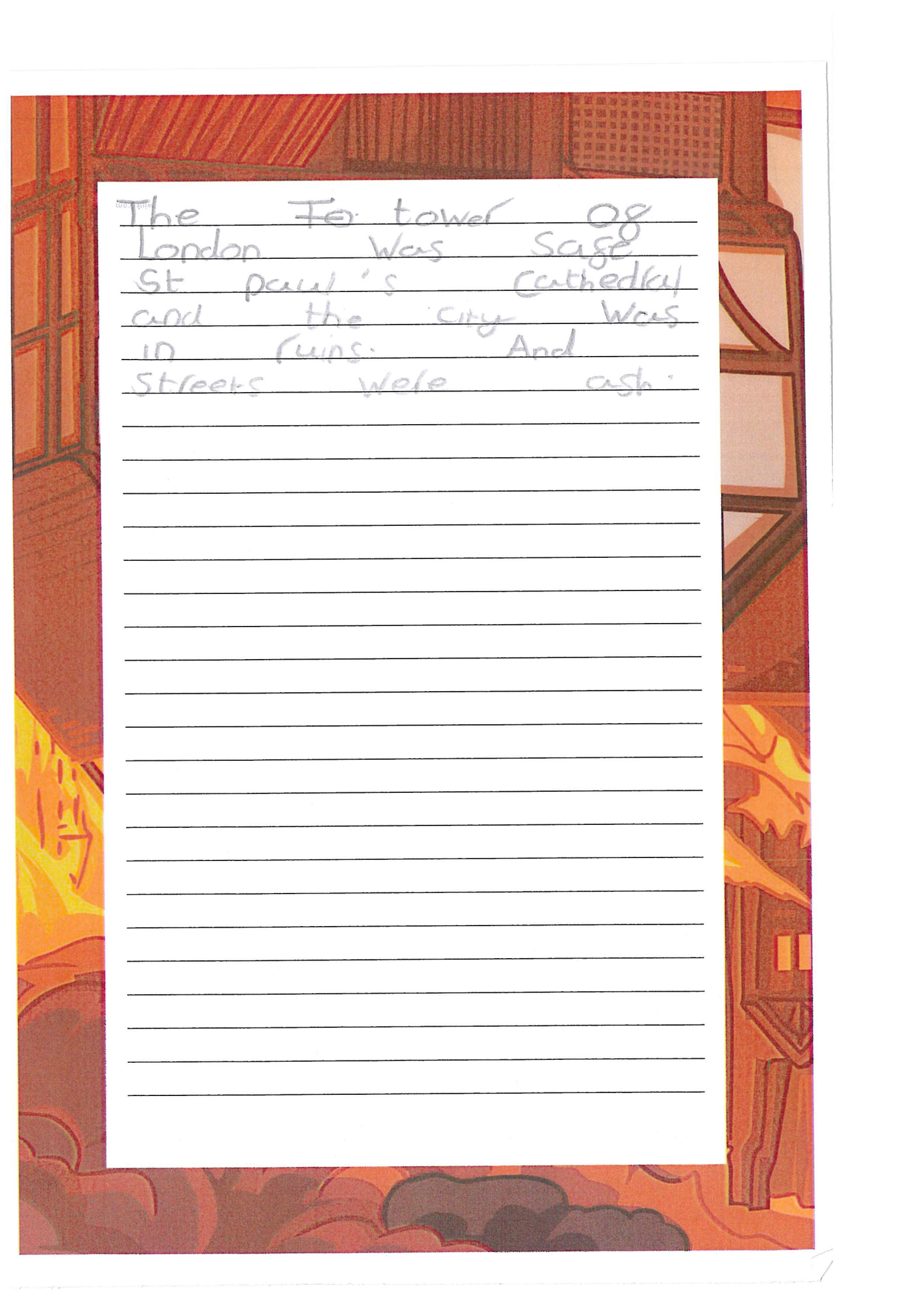
Wednesday the 5th of

 up with and



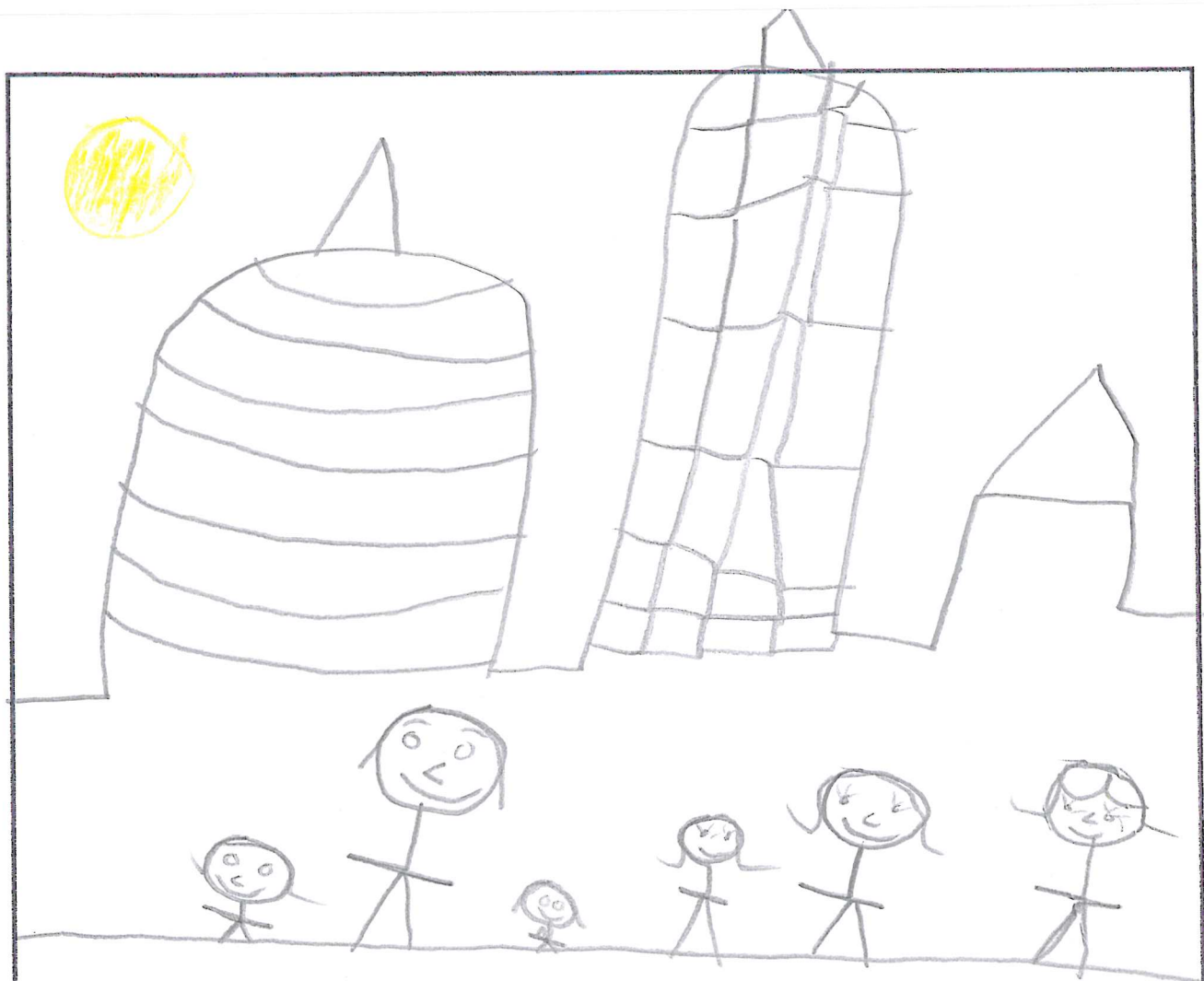
they demolished houses
