



Reception Weekly Update

Monday 25th March – Friday 29th March

We have been celebrating India during our ‘Around the World’ week through:

- Looking at and creating our own Indian patterns on fabric using bright colours
- Listening to Indian music and replicating this using our instruments, then creating our own Indian musical instruments!
- Watching Indian dancing and learning some movements to do our own Indian dance
- Making ‘Kheer’ (an Indian rice pudding) and tasting this together

In Maths we have been:

- Using a number line and number sequences to spot one more and one less
- Comparing bigger and smaller amounts using hoops and adding these amounts together
- Showing this by writing a number sentence e.g. ‘ $5 + 3 = 8$ ’

In Phonics we have been:

- Practising our new digraphs ‘ar’, ‘ow’ and the new tricky word ‘a’. These new digraphs are tricky to distinguish and spot in words so please continue practising these when sharing books together at home!
