

## Year I Knowledge Organiser: Autumn 2 - How will we know what to wear today?



### Key information

When the seasons change, we see the weather pattern change.

Autumn is when the leaves fall off the trees.

Dropping the leaves gives the plant a fresh start in the spring, and the nutrients from the decaying leaves are recycled to help grow the next leafy generation.

The weather patterns and temperature in the United Kingdom changes with each season change.

The United Kingdom is made up of four different countries. England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland.

We can see different weather patterns depending on where in the country we live.

Leaves can make food for the trees.

A leafs job is to turn sunlight into food for the tree.

There are different hours of daylight each month. Day length changes each day.

Weather symbols describe the type of weather we are seeing.

Rainwater falls from clouds in small drops.

The sun is a star that provides light and heat to the Earth.

The wind is a current of air moving across the Earth's surface.

Thunder is a sudden loud noise that comes from the sky during a storm.

Snow is the small, soft, white pieces of ice that sometimes fall from the sky when it is cold.

It is cloudy when the sky is full of clouds which make it seem darker.

A shadow is caused by blocking a source of light.

The days get darker in winter and its feels colder. I wear different clothes as to how hot or cold I feel.

#### What is weather and seasonal changes

The weather patterns are different in each season. A weather forecast is a statement saying what the weather will be like today, the next day or for the next few days. Weather forecasts use different symbols. When the season changes the daylight changes and we may see rainfall changes. You can record the temperature using a thermometer to see how warm or cold it is.

#### How will I find out?

Look at maps to find my and other locations.

Create a rain gauge to measure rainfall.

Create a temperature box to measure temperatures.

Create a windsock to measure wind direction.

Observe shadows and see how they change.
