1. $25 - 8 =$ (Count in ones from 8 up to 10. Count in tens from 10 to 20. Count in ones from 20 to 25. Add up the jumps)

Task 4:

4. Tim has 50p. He buys a sweet for 15p. How much money does he have left?	
5. Jack's mum gives him 40p to spend and he buys a packet of crisps for 23p. How much change does he get?	

Task 5:

Solve these real life word problems, showing the number sentence you use and the working out using a number line.

1. Mandy had 24 gems and her sister gave her 12 more. She then dropped 3 on the floor. How many gems did she has she got now?	
2. Erin had 45p in her pocket and she found 5p more. She then spent 13p. How much money does she have left?	
3. I have 47p and get given another 23p in pocket money. I spend 20p on sweets. How much money do I have left?	
4. Aran measures 75 ml of milk and then spills 20ml on the floor. He then drinks 25ml. How much milk does he have left?	
5. Sarah is 186cm tall. Her brother is 20cm shorter than Sarah and her little sister is 24cm shorter than him. How tall is her little sister?
