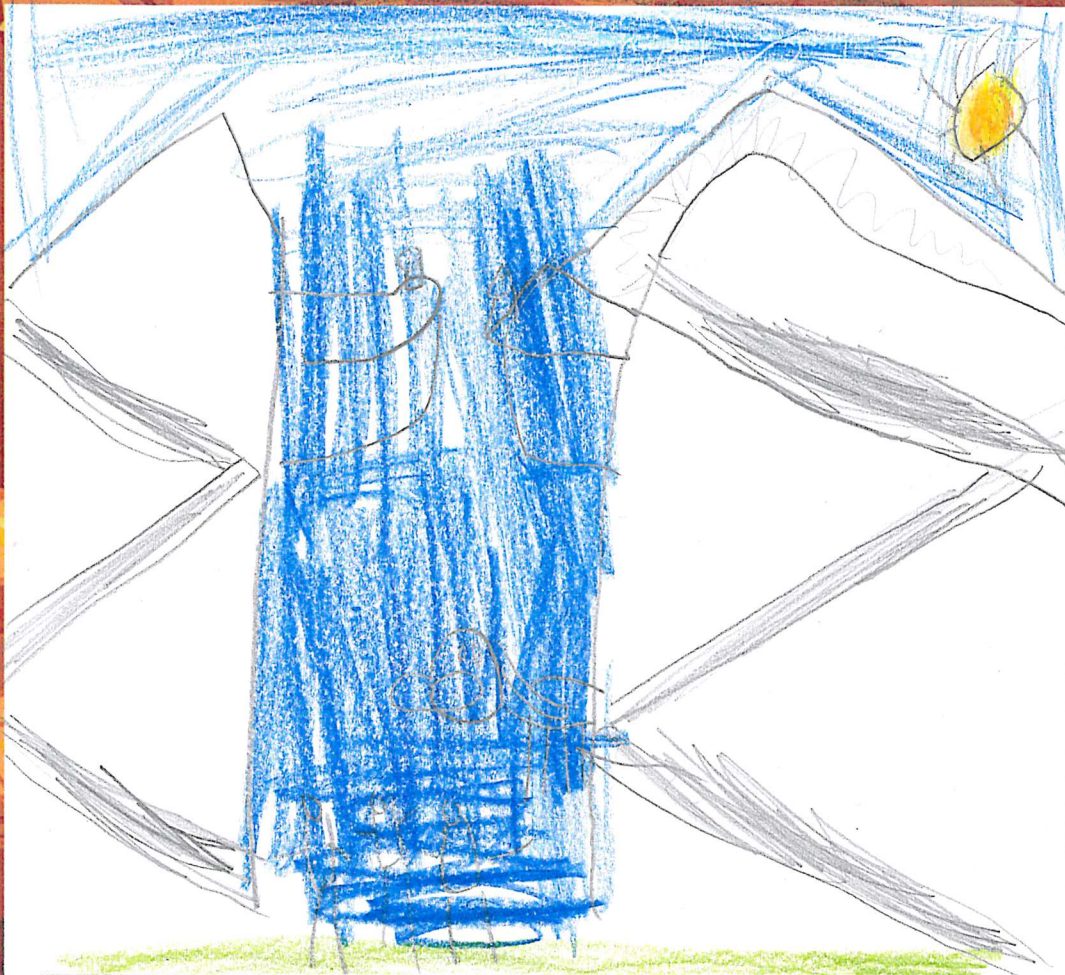

fled across the streets,

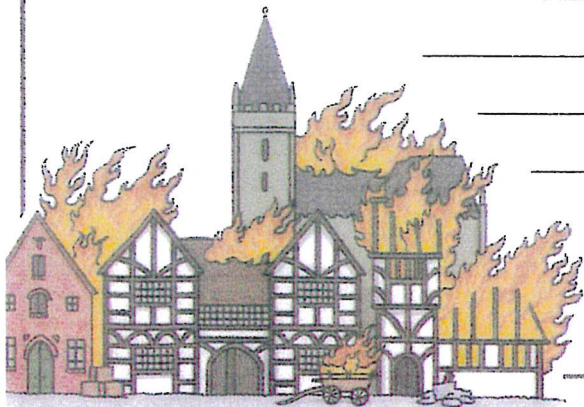


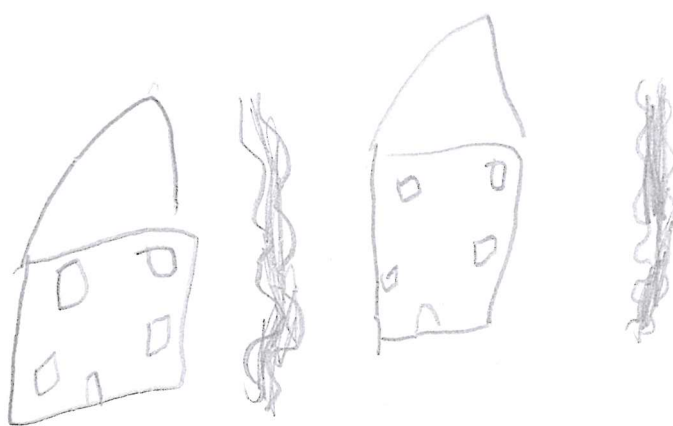
Tuesday 4th ~~dec~~ September
